6 online webinars

The IBF secretariat together with CREA has decided to organize in 2022 a series of six webinars covering the main aspect of buffalo production chain: milk production process, meat production process and sustainability.

International experts on the various disciplines will illustrate the actual situation and latest findings about the topics.

The two-hour webinars will be every one-two month from February on TEAMS platform, starting with the milk production process that will include six webinars:

1. **Buffalo calf management: from birth to weaning**
(nutrition and feeding, welfare, health and pathologies)
2. **Buffalo heifer & cow management**
(nutrition and feeding, welfare, health and pathologies)
3. **Reproduction management**
(puberty, oestrus detection, artificial insemination)
4. **From raw milk to dairy products**
(milk composition and hygienic characteristics, supply chain traceability, cheese processing)
5. **Buffalo for meat production**
(meat production in different rearing systems, meat composition and processing characteristics)
6. **Environment and sustainability of buffalo farming**
(What is sustainability, buffalo farming in different environmental systems, Buffalo: a tool for sustainability)
